The IFSC Statutes review is still underway, therefore, as anticipated, the XIX IFSC General Assembly will not vote on the new articles.

Instead, following the work of the Governance Commission in the past months and the recent Climbing Summit, further discussions on governance and the Statutes will take place, in a specific dedicated session.

As usual, the General Assembly will then address all ordinary items such as Membership, Finance, Sport, and Development, as well as other key topics that impact the organisation and the structure at large.

In the respect of IFSC tradition, IFSC Members will get added value: the programme around the General Assembly will be comprehensive of workshops and other activities for NFs. Last but not least, in line with our continued investment in inclusion, transparency, and democracy, we will facilitate the delegates' participation with financial support, as well as the simultaneous translation service and the possibility to participate remotely.
